The General Assembly adjourned Saturday after 46 days, completing work on landmark energy legislation that includes the core components of the All-American, All of the Above Energy Plan Governor Youngkin laid out last year. The Governor is continuing to make the case for tax cuts that will lower the cost of living and make Virginia competitive.
